

HEARING AND VISION SCREENING

All children age four (4) or older as of September 1 must have a Hearing and Vision Screen and the results must be kept on file at the Child Enrichment Center. THIS HEARING AND VISION SCREEN MUST BE DONE ONCE A CHILD TURNS 4 YEARS OLD AND AGAIN AT 5 YEARS OLD FOR CHILDREN ATTENDING TRANSITION. The Child Enrichment Center is required to compile a report of the testing results and mail the report to the Texas Department of Health.

SCREENING:

- The Child Enrichment Center will screen children in the fall and during the day through a professional agency. The cost will be less than \$20 for both tests. For an additional amount a Speech Screen can also be requested. After school starts, forms requesting this screen will be sent home.
- Parents will receive a copy of the screening results.
- If you choose to have your child screened through your doctor, it must be done at your child's 4 year old checkup and again at 5 year old checkup for Transition students. Please have the doctor complete the form below, then return it to the Child Enrichment Center.

Children failing the screen must be retested. Children failing the second time must be referred to a specialist and the final results kept on file at the Child Enrichment Center.

IF SCREENED BY YOUR DOCTOR IT MUST BE TURNED IN BY SEPTEMBER 1, 2022.

THE CHILD MUST BE 4 YEARS OLD, OR 5 YEARS OLD FOR TRANSITION STUDENTS, AT THE TIME OF TESTING
